






3. Next on the following screen click on the down arrow and scroll to **Western Oklahoma Electrical Training Center** for the **Training Location.**



5. On the next screen enter the information requested and create a password. When you get to **Student Type**: select **Continuing Electrical Training.**




- 6. Selecting Continuing Electrical Training as student type will open up a list of courses.
